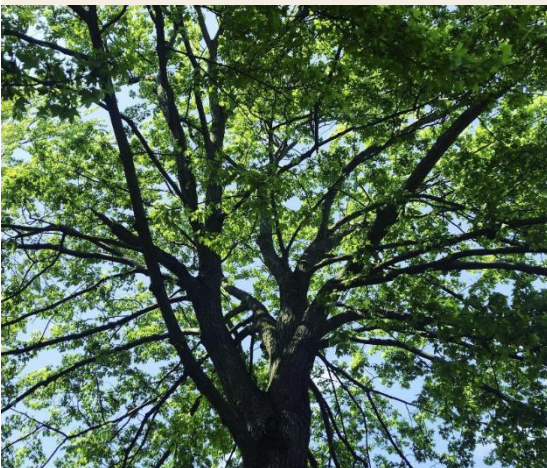


Summer Services
